Three finalists announced for the position of principal of Brown School.

Mark Chitty - Mark is currently serving as principal of the South Elementary School (since 2007) and the Jones Early Childhood Center (since 2008) in Stoughton. Previously Mark was a fifth grade teacher at the Sheehan Elementary School in Westwood for seven years. Mark earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Trevecca Nazarene College, his Master of Education in Elementary Education from Lesley University.

Kirk Downing - Kirk is in his third year as principal of the Chickering School in Dover. His previous experience was as an Assistant Principal at Sunrise Elementary School in Aurora, Colorado and as a teacher in grades 1-5 at Summit elementary and Peakview Elementary Schools, also in Aurora Colorado. Kirk holds a Bachelor's Degree in History and a Master's Degree in Education from the University of Colorado, Boulder.

Matthew Joseph - Since 2006, Matthew has served as principal of the Hill-Roberts Elementary School in Attleboro. Previously he worked for two years as a Technology Integration Specialist for the Berkshire Wireless Learning Initiative in Pittsfield and for seven years as a Grade 3 and Grade 5 classroom teacher at the Morningside Elementary School, also in Pittsfield.
