NATICK PUBLIC SCHOOLS - INCLEMENT WEATHER – BUS ROUTES

During inclement weather, our goal is to safely transport students to and from school. This may result in students arriving to school or home later than expected. The transportation providers do their very best to insure the safety of all on board.

The Superintendent of Schools, and DPW management, recently met to review inclement weather priorities. The DPW workers first attend to the main roads, hills, schools, and then enter neighborhood streets for clearing.

In inclement weather, the bus stops will stay the same whenever possible. The elementary routes should not change. If a driver is not able to enter a particular neighborhood due to road conditions, the School Department Transportation Office should be notified immediately. We will make every effort to notify the DPW, and they will send assistance. Should that not be possible, we will notify the parents of students on the bus and request that an adult(s) meet the bus to accompany the students' home safely. As long as road conditions allow, the Middle School and High School bus routes will run as advertised. Any route modification will only be made by the School Department, as deemed necessary. The Transportation Office will remain in constant contact with the School Secretary, and the transportation providers' dispatcher.
